

Mud Creek Cemetery #1B
(Also known as "Slave Cemetery")

Approximately 114 Graves

Legend:

Rows start at the entrance or front of the Cemetery.

R: Graves are located on the right side of the Cemetery.

L: Graves are located on the left side of the Cemetery.

M: Graves are located in the middle of the Cemetery.

B: Back half of Cemetery.

Row and Lot numbers, plus locations, are to help locate graves.

There are many graves marked only with a fieldstone and are not numbered. There are many unmarked graves, indicated by a mound, which are not numbered.

The back half of the Cemetery has fieldstone markers, cement block markers, and metal temporary markers from the Booker T. Washington Burial Society and Smith and Gaston, but the names are no longer legible..

Row 1 has estimated: 3 fieldstone grave markers and 0 unmarked graves.

Row 2 has estimated: 3 fieldstone grave markers and 4 unmarked graves.

Row 3 has estimated: 5 fieldstone grave markers and 0 unmarked graves.

Row 4 has estimated: 6 fieldstone grave markers and 0 unmarked graves.

Row 5 has estimated: 6 fieldstone grave markers and 3 unmarked graves.

Row 6 has estimated: 9 fieldstone grave markers and 0 unmarked graves.

Back half of Cemetery: 52 fieldstone grave markers and 4 unmarked graves.

Total: 84 fieldstone grave markers and 11 unmarked graves.

One grave marked with cement headstone with no information: Row 6, Lot 2, L

One grave marked with 2 corner stones with the letter "T" on them: Back half of Cemetery.

History has it that the first slaved buried in this cemetery was a man slave of Billie Wood. He is buried in the back right had corner. There are the remains of what may be the cedar cross placed there by Billie Wood.
